

### Virtual Classroom - Pallas PL006




- Ground floor Pallas building at Park

### Virtual Classroom – Pallas PL006




- Software provided by BARCO

- 1 x View of shared content




### Virtual Classroom – PL006

- Interactive whiteboard (shareable)






