General Description

You will want to explore the relationship between climate change, landscape and water; and share our enthusiasm for practical, effective design, whether urban or rural, and for sustainable landscape solutions, such as green infrastructure and renewable energy solutions. You will have an understanding of the relationship of wider environmental issues with landscape architecture. You will be competent in MS Office and Adobe Creative Suite (Photoshop, Indesign, Illustrator). We also work extensively with ArcGIS and one of the posts would suit a person wishing to use and explore visualisation with Arc. We also use AutoCAD, Windfarm, Sketchup and Vectorworks; knowledge of these packages is desirable but not essential and on-the-job training will be provided. ArcGIS is used in the delivery of most projects at JBA and this post offers an opportunity to build a high degree of competency in this software package.

As we work across the UK and this post requires undertaking site assessments and photography, a full driving licence is essential.
